Paul gives four aspects of the walk of the Gentiles, which illustrate the absolute futility and insane purpose of the life of the lost man. 1. "In the vanity of their mind or the futility of their thinking" means the empty illusion of the life that thinks there is satisfaction in sin. The Bible teaches that sin appears pleasurable for a season. 2. "Having the understanding darkened" means that the lost man has lost his _____ of moral values. 3. "Being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them" is a picture of all mankind without Christ. The result is a hardening of the heart. Hardening "is used medically to denote the callus formed when a bone has been fractured and reset. Such a callus is even harder than the bone itself." Romans 1:21, 1 Corinthians 1:18, 1 Corinthians 2:14 Each time we the tug from the Holy Spirit, and don't repent, our heart becomes a little more hardened and stubborn to change. 4. "Who, being past feeling, have given themselves over unto lasciviousness [which is uncleanness], to work all uncleanness with greediness [or covetousness]." Licentiousness is sin that flaunts itself, throwing off all restraint and having no sense of shame or fear; they don't care if they shock people. Uncleanness is a broad word, mostly with reference to sexual impropriety. Also defined as unbridled lust. Vs. 20-21 Don't call Jesus teacher if your not willing to be taught by Him. The key to this passage of scripture: Vs. 22-24 There is a sacrifice. Biblical change will not happen by accident or by osmosis Wisdom is the _____ of knowledge (Hebrews 5:14) Change is _____ for entrance into God's kingdom! We are to put off the old man and put on the new man in the same manner that we change our clothes. It is like putting off an old and unclean garment and then putting on a garment that is new and clean.
